About 15 women were present and there was a round of names and groups represented

Minutes from June 22 meeting were distributed and debated
Question as to whether the motion re: Speaker's list had been defeated or passed

Motion : that discussion be reopened re: Speaker's list

Vote : Passed

An agenda was formed and passed

Business : 1. Voting Eligibility : proposals

a) to be eligible to vote a woman had to have attended anyone previous meeting

b) must have attended the previous meeting

c) any woman who had attended one previous meeting of main body or any sub-body may vote

Vote was taken on proposal 'C' : defeated.

2. Speaker's list : proposals

a) informal speaker's list will operate unless a formal written list is deemed necessary by chair or by vote of meeting

b) formal written speaker's list for all discussions

Motion : the use of a written speaker's list will be left to the discretion of the chair unless decided by vote of meeting

Vote : Passed.

3. Policy re: money

Announcement was made that \$20 owed to Video Link was donated back to L.A.R.E.

Motion : expenses incurred while performing delegated tasks will be paid by group - an approximate budget will be set at the time the task is assigned.

Vote : passed.

4. Gay Community Center letter and march:

The Gay Community Center has requested that L.A.R.E. be a visible presence at the Gay Festival / Aug 1st + 2nd. They would like a banner in the March, us to sponsor a workshop, possibly with video tape of Lesbian Conference workshop and someone to speak on a panel. There was discussion as to whether L.A.R.E. was cohesive enough as a group to be represented at this event.

General agreement that banner was not possible.

Motion : that the video tape taken at Lesbian Conference workshop be shown at the Gay Festival workshop / that the speakers go as themselves not representing L.A.R.E. / but will explain history of group as a way of advertising.

Amendment : that 4 people go as representatives of L.A.R.E. present video, facilitate discussion and plug L.A.R.E.

Vote : passed.

Ellen, Dorrie, Sara and Frances volunteered to do workshop.

5. Presentation:

Since we had little time left and one woman who was to give a presentation was missing, it was decided to have the presentation next meeting at the beginning of the agenda with a discussion re:

- word 'Right' is vague, clique - will not be clear who we are against.

It was decided that any vote on name must be tabled for next meeting.
