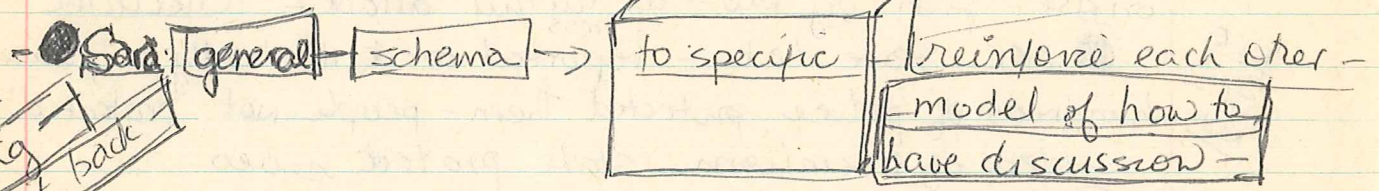

The Right: Its Overall Impact

- ① Right's goal is sweeping changes in ~~structure~~ society - would preserve basic structure - goal is control over ^{power} motifs of society
- ② Orig'd R/W - diff. relationship to organized repression by ~~power~~ ^{structure of} society → at diff. stages of econ. pol. sit'g of its own development -
- ③ Right grows in periods of social, economic and political crisis (tend to overlap) - institutions basic to ^{hierarchical} society + maintaining power of ruling elite are eroded + in crisis → reach to R/W as sol. corps, church, prem. sectors of state: ARMY, politicians linked to ^{ruling interests} _{mass & public}
- ④ Space for Right to put out its solutions based on general $\frac{1}{2}$ growing dissatisfaction and pain people feeling w/ lives -
 - middle class
 - unemployed - youth
 - traditional family- trying to understand why expectations not realized → scapegoats, easy explanations
- perspective of right: Mass movement
- ⑤ - failure of progressive movements to org. broadly + provide answers
 - total physical defeat of resist. - Germany, Spain
 - Chile

4. The Right and Its Overall Impact.

① The organized far right has a different relationship to organized repression by other forces in society at different stages of the political process

* Moral Majority
pressured to withdraw from 50 prog

- at times org'd far right comes into conflict with the state, big capital - but they do have a role

- right grows in periods of social, economic, political crisis -

(tend to go together) when institutions of society that capitalism + patriarchy depend on are eroded - recessions - corps, church (schools), STATE (+ gov) ARMY etc.

- space for right to put out its solutions based in: general + growing pain + dissatisfaction which people are feeling with their lives - espec. ~~lower~~ p.b., unemployed - trying to understand why expectations not realized - scapegoats + reasons: opening

- ② failure of progressive movements to org. broadly + provide answers, and ③ ultimately, when R/W org'd + left, P etc - the ~~total~~ total defeat of left -

- STAGES: ① fringe group - keeps people in line - state turns its face - UNION-BUSTING - of Artistic woodwork - 30-65 mill. evang. US

② R/W growing: conflict between liberal points + certain layers of capital + far right - not yet mass movement - but pop/eng. USA -> probs - mass fronts, armed groups

③ org'd R/W provides cover for state repression - unions - right to work - Eng - abortion - failed - USA - evang. preachers + politicians - coal. working/business - HIDE direct family groups

④ US ♀ - Survey Mem. - Van Gen. - sources - plot - abortion - act. - no. empty - control - prog. - speaking to ♀ - seen as threatening ongoing stability of govt (state) + capitalism - right now ♀'s movement - more than ever - espec. US in other places - unions

⑤ in last instance - when crisis like 1930s + when resistance when have to force people to work for nothing etc -> Corps support actual govt by org'd far right - Spain, Germany, Chile - RELI on mass movement - if poss. do thru consens. govt (Reagan) - fasism - she right 1p org - no' liberated

only can happen when left CRUSHED ♀'s movement.
